

Library Facilities

【Reading Seats】

All reading areas are available with electronic outlets.

【Search Terminals】

There are terminals available for searching library materials and make requests to pick up items in ASRS.

【Wi-Fi】

Visitors from eduroam participating institutions can use the eduroam network.
Check your institution's instruction and set up your device.

【1F Refresh Room / 3F Cafe (Lounge)】

Food and drinks are acceptable.

* No food or drinks (except for covered drink containers) allowed in other areas.

【2F Audio-Visual Booths】

There are 6 audio-visual booths where you can watch or listen to the library's audio-visual materials (DVD, video and cassette). Please apply at the counter with your library card. You may borrow headphones.

Classification and Arrangement

【Books】

We shelve about 80,000 frequently used books in the 4F-4A Student Book Area and place the others on each floor by classification.

Shelving follows the Nippon Decimal Classification (NDC) and is arranged in call number order.

【Periodicals】

Current periodicals are shelved on 3F-3A, and back numbers are on 3F-3D.

• Japanese periodicals : in Japanese alphabetical order.

• Foreign periodicals : in A-Z alphabetical order.

Central Library

Library Card

- Library user cards are issued to those who wish to continue using the library and borrowing materials for research purposes. The user card can be used at all Kyushu University libraries : Central, Science and Technology, Design, and Chikushi, except Medical Library.

Renewing Your Library Card

Your library card expires on March 31 every year. Renewal applications are accepted from February. To renew, please submit an application form and your library card, showing your ID document verifies your current address.

Entering / Leaving

- Hold your card over and pass the gate.
- If you are not carrying a library card with you, please fill out a form to issue a temporary card.
- If you have library materials not checked out properly, the security system sounds an alarm.

Browsing

- You can browse and read materials on open stacks and read at reading areas.
- To access materials on closed stacks, please make an application at the counter.
- You can request materials shelved in Automated Storage and Retrieval System (ASRS) from designated PCs in the library.

Photocopying

- Self-service copy machines are available.

- * The copyright law stipulates an individual may make a single copy from a portion of a library material for nonprofit research / educational purposes.

Borrowing

You can borrow library materials, when presenting a library card for "Reading + Borrowing."

Borrowable: up to 2 items

Loan Period: 2 weeks * No renewable.

- Only books in open stacks and ASRS are available to borrow.
- Your borrowing privileges may be restricted during exam terms.
Notice will be dropped on our website or SNS.
- Books on loan may be recalled upon a request by Kyushu University's affiliated members.
- We will demand you for a compensation if you damage or lost a library book.

Returning

- Please return library materials at the counter by the due date. When the library is closed, the book drops in front of the library are available.
- If books are not returned by the due date, your borrowing privilege will be suspended.
- You can return library materials at any libraries of Kyushu University.

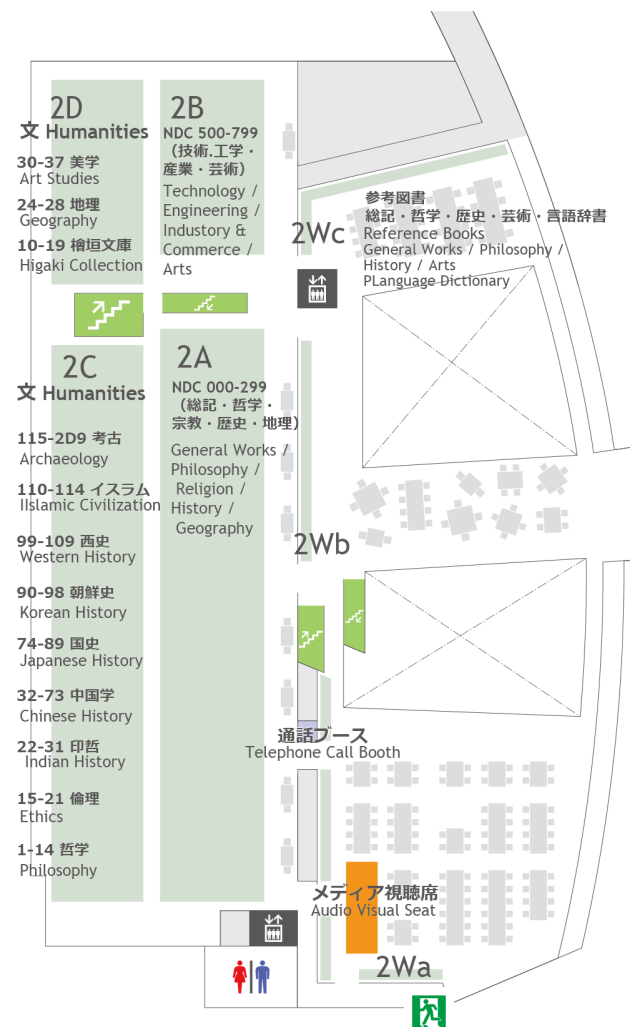


Refresh Space (1F)
